

A PERFECT PLACE FOR ENTREPRENEURS

Business plots are highly affordable in Harjavalta, and they are available to buy or let. In addition to industrial plots, there are good business plots for commercial operators.

The Harjavalta industrial park is home to some twenty companies that co-operate closely with each other. The companies operate, for instance, in the fields of metallurgy, chemicals industry, process energy utilisation and fields supporting these. The total number of employees at the industrial park is over one thousand, plus the employees of over one hundred subcontractors.

AN EASY START

Harjavalta supports entrepreneurs actively and through long-term planning. New companies receive free counselling on how to start and develop their business. The business advisor helps the companies with calculations and introduces the support measures, development projects and business development services available.

Co-operation between the companies is active, which provides subcontractors with excellent networking opportunities. Harjavalta has the highest self-sufficiency rate in the labour market in inland Finland: over 130%!

Social services



SERVICES FOR ALL AGES

Harjavalta offers good basic social services to people of all ages. The services available at the health centre include a physician's reception, non-institutional health care, home care, maternity and child health clinic and school and student health care. The health centre also provides occupational and oral health care, local hospital operations, services for the seriously disabled and mental health and substance abuse rehabilitation services.

The town offers a variety of services for the elderly to support living at home and Harjavalta also has several housing units for elderly and a retirement home.

EVERYDAY ENCOUNTERS

The social security provided by Harjavalta covers home services for families with children, preventative family work (including substance abuse services), as well as advice, guidance and support for people of all ages.

The town of Harjavalta wants to support its residents throughout their lives, in times of challenges, joys and sorrows. There are also diverse services for adults that cover different situations in life. Most important is to consider each customer as an individual and provide them with the help, services and supportive measures they need.

For children and young people



Harjavalta offers high-quality early education and schooling for its young residents. Municipal day care is provided by both day care centres and family care. Day care services for shift workers are also available.

Harjavalta has two excellent primary schools and one secondary school. The town organises afternoon activities for small schoolchildren. After secondary school, the pupils can continue to the local general upper secondary school, which is located in the education complex in central Harjavalta.

The local youth club is like a shared, casual living room. It is open on most week nights and Sundays, welcoming young people to listen to music, relax on the couch, watch TV or films, play games and simply spend time with their friends. Theme nights are organised a few times per month, based on the wishes of the young people.

Harjavalta youth work organises a range of activities that support the growth and well-being of children and young people, including clubs, camps, trips and events, ensuring that everyone has meaningful things to do.

Construction and the environment



Harjavalta has plenty of room for new residents. There are affordable plots in different environments: from the peace and quiet of nature to the immediate vicinity of services. Living areas range from vast fields to beautiful pine forests, and new plots are also made available on the riverbank based on demand. The plots are affordable and spacious.


The many sports clubs and associations of Harjavalta also offer a wide choice of free time activities, from gymnastics and fishing to archery.




Emil Cedercreutz Museum
